

15 Bible verses for a Daily Bible Study Routine for New Christians

A daily Bible study routine helps new Christians grow in faith, starting with prayer for wisdom

1. Begin with Prayer & Seek Wisdom

1. James 1:5 – “If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.”

2. Psalm 119:105 – “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.”

2. Start with the Gospel & Salvation

1. John 3:16 – “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

2. Romans 10:9 – “That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”

3. Learn About Spiritual Growth

1. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 – “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.”

2. Colossians 2:6-7 – “As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith.”

4. Develop a Habit of Prayer & Trust in God

1. Philippians 4:6-7 – “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.”

2. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 – “Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”

5. Strengthen Your Faith & Overcome Challenges

1. Isaiah 41:10 – “Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you.”

2. Hebrews 11:6 – “But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.”

6. Love & Serve Others

1. John 13:34-35 – “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.”

2. Galatians 5:13 – “For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.”

7. Stay Committed to Your Faith

1. Joshua 1:8 – “This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night.”

2. Matthew 6:33 – “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”

3. 2 Peter 3:18 – “But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.”
